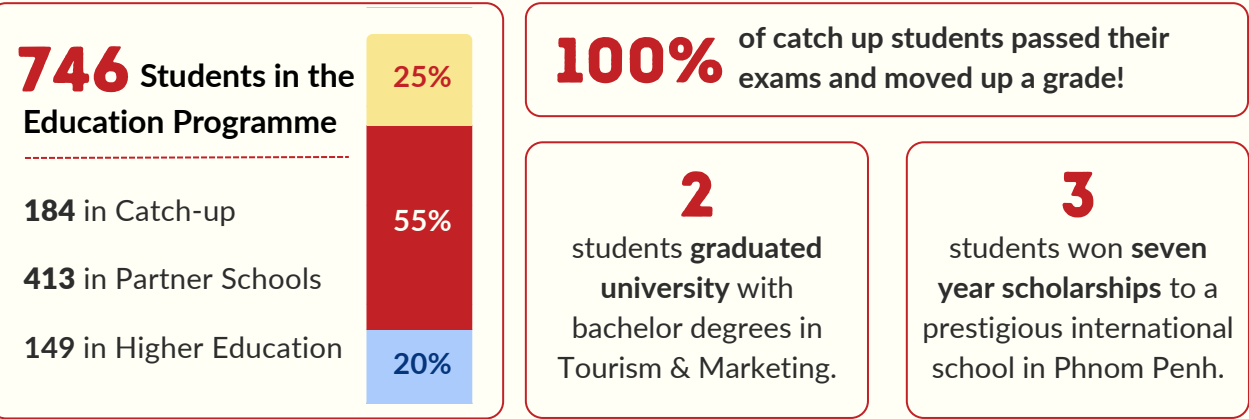


BECAUSE OF YOUR SUPPORT,

100% exam pass rate

From January to June, 184 students in our Catch-Up programme prepared for their exams. **All 184 students passed. That's a 100% success rate.**

For students who only joined us in November 2024 – most after years out of school – this is an extraordinary achievement. The majority of our second year students are on track to start at partner schools at the start of the next academic year in October.



Staying in school, thanks to you

From January to June, **413 former Catch-Up students** continued their education in local schools. Each day, **they return to ISF for breakfast and lunch**, English and computer classes, football, and group sessions focused on confidence, soft skills, and goal setting. This ongoing support helps them **stay in school and believe in their future.**

Your long-term support makes that stability possible. It means children and families in our communities have the **everyday basics** that often stand between them and the chance to learn.

Beyond the Classroom

This term wasn't only about exams. Between January to June:

- Over 500 students went to the cinema and water park.
- 44 students took part in a special art project.
- Over 40 students joined our annual 5K fun run.
- Our school football teams competed (and won!) in football tournaments and the weekly youth league.

These moments helped students build confidence, community, and joy, as important as any classroom lesson.

Real-world support for the next step

This term, **149 young people** pursued the next stage of their journey as part of our Higher Education & Employment Programme.

- 95 students are studying at university.
- 54 young people are receiving tailored career support, including internships, vocational training, job interviews, and guidance.

Your support provided:

- Free breakfast & lunch for our students.
- Healthcare from our on-site nurses.
- Monthly food parcels for 700+ families.
- Uniforms, transport & school supplies.
- A place to feel safe and supported.
